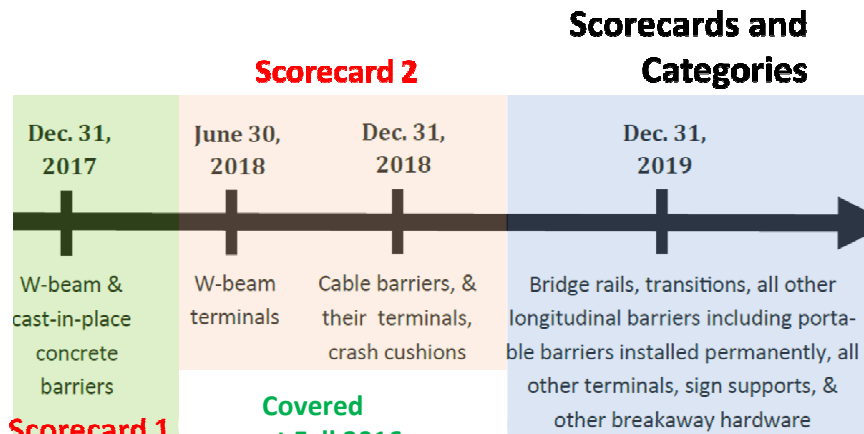

Temporary work zone devices

(including portable barriers not installed permanently) manufactured after December 31, 2019, must have been successfully tested to the 2016 edition of MASH. Such devices manufactured on or before this date, and successfully tested to NCHRP Report 350 or the 2009 edition of MASH, may continue to be used throughout their normal service lives.

# Overall Approach at the Meeting

## *To identifying candidates for voting*

*We went through scorecard 1 and 2 last year. This year's major focus is Scorecard 3 items, along with some "housekeeping". One suggested approach is to **go through the following, in this order, and one-by-one, decide which items to move forward for voting:***

FIRST, go through **Ongoing projects – next phases** and I.D. candidates for voting -

SECOND: go over any **Missed items from Scorecard 1 and Scorecard 2** and I.D. candidates for voting (likely few or none of these) .  
**Will outreach to group prior to the meeting**

THIRD: go through **Scorecard 3a, 3b, 3c & 3d** and I.D. candidates for voting –  
**Working on these**

FOURTH: go through **Prior year un-funded items** and I.D. candidates for voting  
– **We have this list...**

**THEN, as a group: does this give us a "full slate" for voting? If not move onto:**

5) 3e Bridge Rail

**THEN, as a group: does this give us a "full slate" for voting? If not move onto:**

6) 3f Sign Supports & other breakaway hardware
